

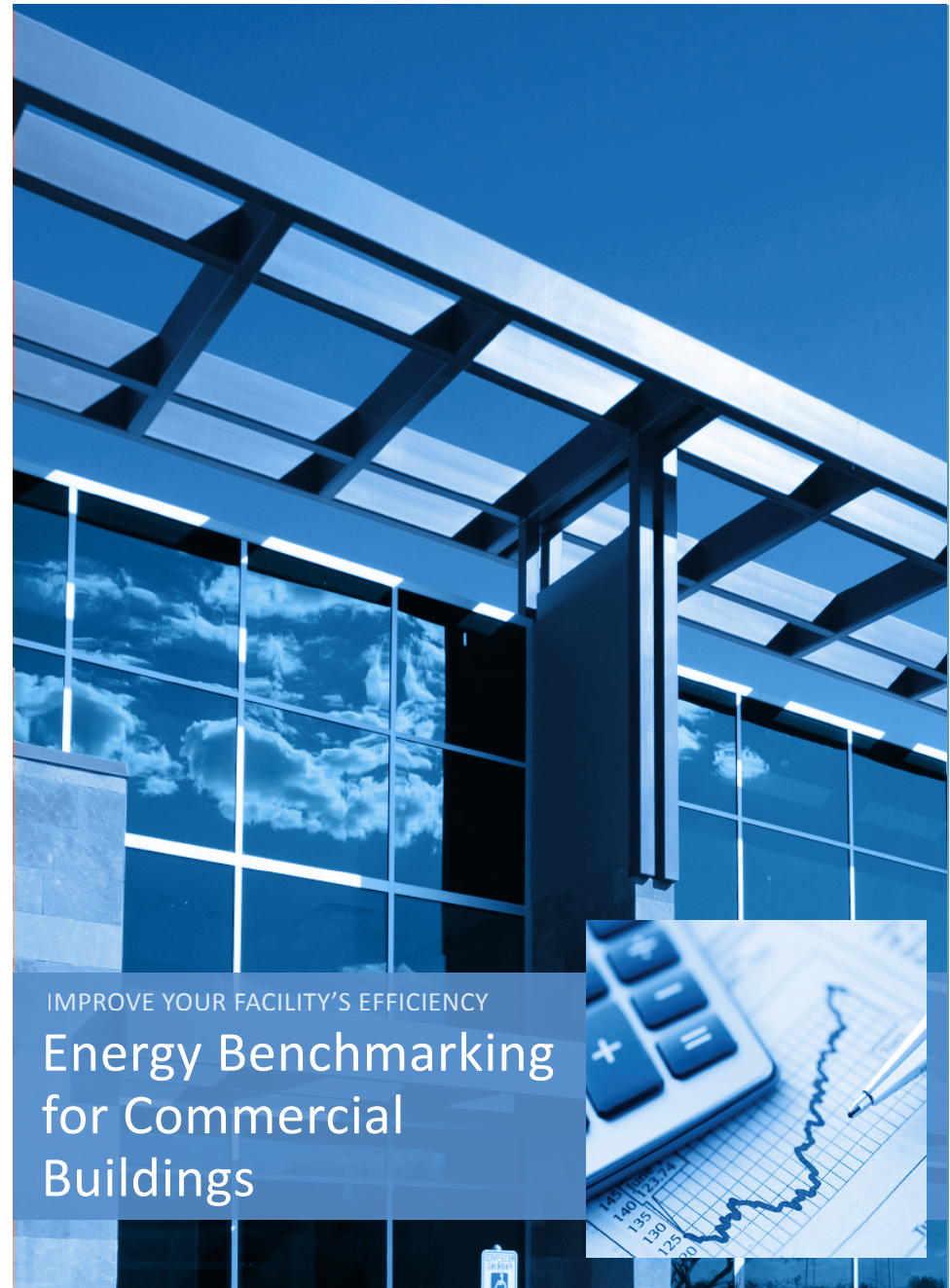

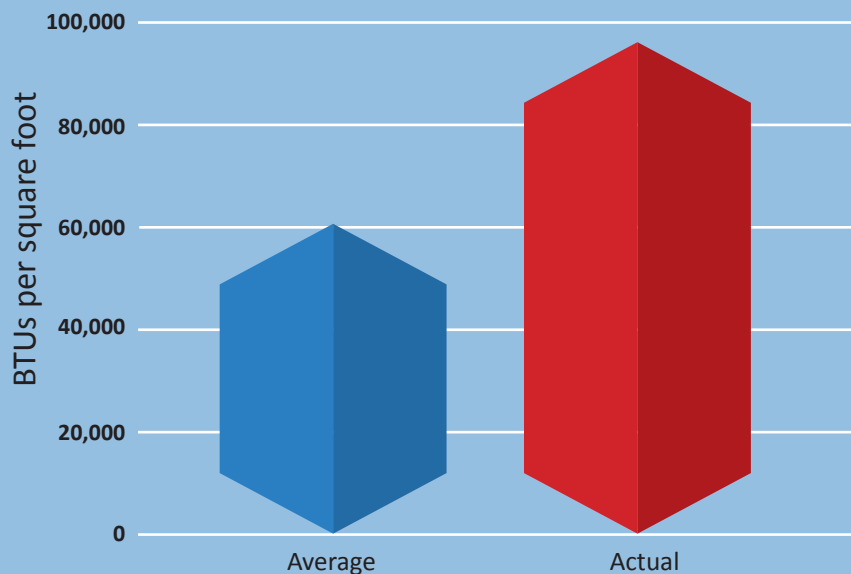

## Is your building costing you more to operate than it should?



This question will be answered through your local public power utility's EnergyWise<sup>SM</sup> free benchmarking process. Through this process, utility billing information is gathered for your facility and divided by square footage to obtain a measure of energy usage that allows buildings of different sizes to be compared. The results can be a big help in identifying opportunities for energy-efficient upgrades.

## The process is simple, fast, and FREE!

Your local public power utility will assist with:

- Gathering information such as utility billing history and building area.
- Entering information into databases.
- Reviewing reports showing annual energy usage.
  - ENERGY STAR<sup>®</sup> Portfolio Manager can be used to provide an Energy Performance Rating. This rating, on a scale of 1 to 100, lets you know how your building compares to other similar facilities.
  - Your facility may also be compared using indices such as kWh/sq.ft. and therms/sq.ft.
- Depending on the results and potential opportunities, your utility will assist you in selecting the best approach to improve your facility's energy performance. Most facilities will fall into one of the following categories:

**Your building is performing superbly.**

Continue to monitor your building's performance and apply for the ENERGY STAR<sup>®</sup> label.

**Your building could use efficiency help.**

Take advantage of EnergyWise<sup>SM</sup> incentive programs available through your electric utility.
