

How to read your bill

Questions regarding your bill? You can call Perennial or visit our website if you have any questions about your bill or any other service questions.

Detailed Account Information

Specific information such as energy usage, rate schedule, account activity and other key details regarding your account can be found here.

Definitions of rate components

Facility Charge - The monthly expense of providing the minimum amount of equipment necessary for a customer to access the electric grid. This would include poles, wires, meters and transformers.

Energy Purchased Power - The monthly expense associated with the generation and transmission of power purchased from our supplier, Nebraska Public Power District. **Energy Distribution Delivery** - The expense to deliver the power to customers across Perennial's distribution network.

How do I make a payment?

Return this portion of the bill with your payment. You can mail your payment in the return envelope provided, pay in person at the Perennial office or drop in nearest Perennial drop-box. You can also pay online by signing up for E-billing. We accept Visa, Mastercard, Discover, e-checks recurring payment program or bank draft.
